INSTRUCTIONS

- Connect your vacuum on an electric circuit in conformity to the specifications indicated on the identification plaque found on your vacuum cleaner.
- The machine should be installed in an area where the temperature does not exceed 40°C.
- Avoid placing objects on your machine. Make sure that nothing blocks or penetrates the ventilation openings of the motor.
- If suction decreases:
- 1- Clean the filter by hand-shaking it. Certain dust particles may block the filter more easily than others (ex. gyproc dust).
- 2- Empty the canister.
- 3- Check all the rubber parts placed inside the covers found on the wall outlets.
- If the motor stops, re-start by pressing on the reset button.
- The cleaning of the canister should generally be done every three (3) or four (4) months.
- You may wash the filter with soapy water.
- Check the brushes carbon at 500 hours of use (only domestic use).

ATTENTION: Never use vacuum without the filter.
